

Al-Ayn's medical aid programmes provide comprehensive healthcare to thousands of orphaned children in Iraq. Our health clinics contain the latest equipment and devices, staffed by expert medical practitioners who offer free, long-term healthcare to children. Our clinics also respond to emergencies within 24 hours to ensure that patients receive the medical attention they urgently require.

The medical centre functions as a miniature hospital and comprises of the following specialist clinics:



Paediatric



Dental



ENT



General Medical

In addition to these clinics there is also a pharmacy, a laboratory, and an X-ray room.





LED BY EXPERTS,

TAILORED TO EVERY CHILD

Every child who visits our clinics receives a healthcare plan tailored to their needs. Medical professionals dedicate their time and services to the centre and liaise with hospitals and physicians inside and outside of Iraq so that orphaned children with more complex needs can be supported. Al-Ayn currently operates three medical clinics with more than 20 different specialist doctors from various fields.



? Did you know?

Al-Ayn's medical clinic in Baghdad treats approximately 100 patients daily, from 9am to 8pm. While most patients are widowed mothers and orphaned children with valid registrations, the facility is also accessible to the general public for a small charge, with the proceeds going towards assisting the orphaned children that Al-Ayn supports.



IDENTIFYING NEEDS

At Al-Ayn's distribution centres, where families receive their monthly financial aid, dedicated staff assess the medical care requirements of each and every child. Following a thorough check-up for any conditions, and after diagnosis, the child is referred to the appropriate clinic, where treatments and procedures commence. If a child requires treatment outside of Iraq, Al-Ayn organises the travel arrangements and covers the orphaned child's travel costs, including accommodation, food, and medical care, until they return home.

SURGICAL PROCEDURES

To date over 95,000 orphaned children have been treated in Iraq, and over 2,000 surgeries have been successfully completed. In instances where the medical centre is unequipped, it collaborates with hospitals and medical professionals domestically and internationally to treat the orphaned children. Further to this, in order to acquire supplies and commodities, there is currently ongoing international cooperation and contact with global neighbours, including Iran, Lebanon, Turkey, and India.

DILIGENT AFTERCARE

Al-Ayn stays in touch with the child and monitors their progress until complete recovery. Additionally, children with chronic illnesses have access to a pharmacy card which allows them to obtain the medication they require on a frequent basis.

? Did you know?

1,878 children with special needs have received care from Al-Ayn, which encompasses all their daily needs as well as their medical care, which includes diagnosis, treatment, and surgical procedures.



CASE STUDY

"We had an awful car accident. My head was hurting a lot after that. The doctors said I needed an operation and Al-Ayn took care of it. I don't feel any pain in my head anymore!"

Baraa's surgical operation is one of over 2,000 that Al-Ayn has undertaken for orphaned children in Iraq, with at least 300 of these conducted abroad.
