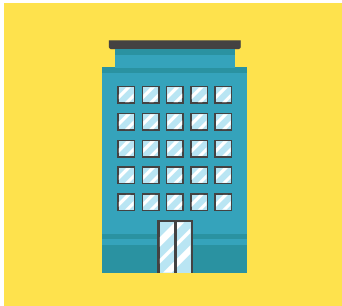

Shajarat Tuba Complex: A Lifeline for Orphaned Families in Karbala

The Shajarat Tuba Complex, currently under construction in Karbala, is a monumental project designed to serve vulnerable orphaned children and their families. A key feature of this complex is the integration of a Luminous Stars Centre, spanning five floors. Each floor will provide dedicated services, including comprehensive medical care, mental health support, and vocational training to empower children and families.

The remaining floors will operate as a hotel for the pilgrims of Imam Hussain (AS). The profits generated from the hotel will fund additional initiatives to support orphaned children in need, creating a sustainable model of care and empowerment.

Key Services

Our services are designed to address the diverse and interconnected needs of orphaned children and their families, ensuring a holistic approach to care. The key aspects include:



Medical Care

Access to specialised healthcare, including dentistry, ENT services, and general treatments, to safeguard the health and wellbeing of every child.



Psychological Rehabilitation

Trauma can leave deep, invisible scars. Our counselling and mental health programmes help children heal and regain their confidence.



Educational Support

From academic resources to tutoring, we ensure children have access to quality education, opening doors to opportunity and breaking the cycle of poverty.



Vocational Training

Empowering youth and widowed mothers with practical skills in fields such as tailoring, IT, and catering, helping them achieve financial independence.



Financial Assistance

Monthly aid to cover essentials like food, clothing, and shelter, providing immediate relief and a foundation for stability.

Our Luminous Stars Centres offer comprehensive care for over 100,000 orphaned children and their families each month, providing education, healthcare, psychological support, and skill development. With 11 centres established, this pioneering network ensures holistic growth in a safe environment, transforming lives by addressing all aspects of a child's wellbeing.

Thanks to the generosity of our supporters, these centres have achieved remarkable success, evidenced by the improved health, education, and emotional wellbeing of the children we serve. Building on this success, we aim to expand into underserved, deprived areas of Iraq—regions with high rates of poverty and limited access to essential services, replicating this proven model to reach more children in need.

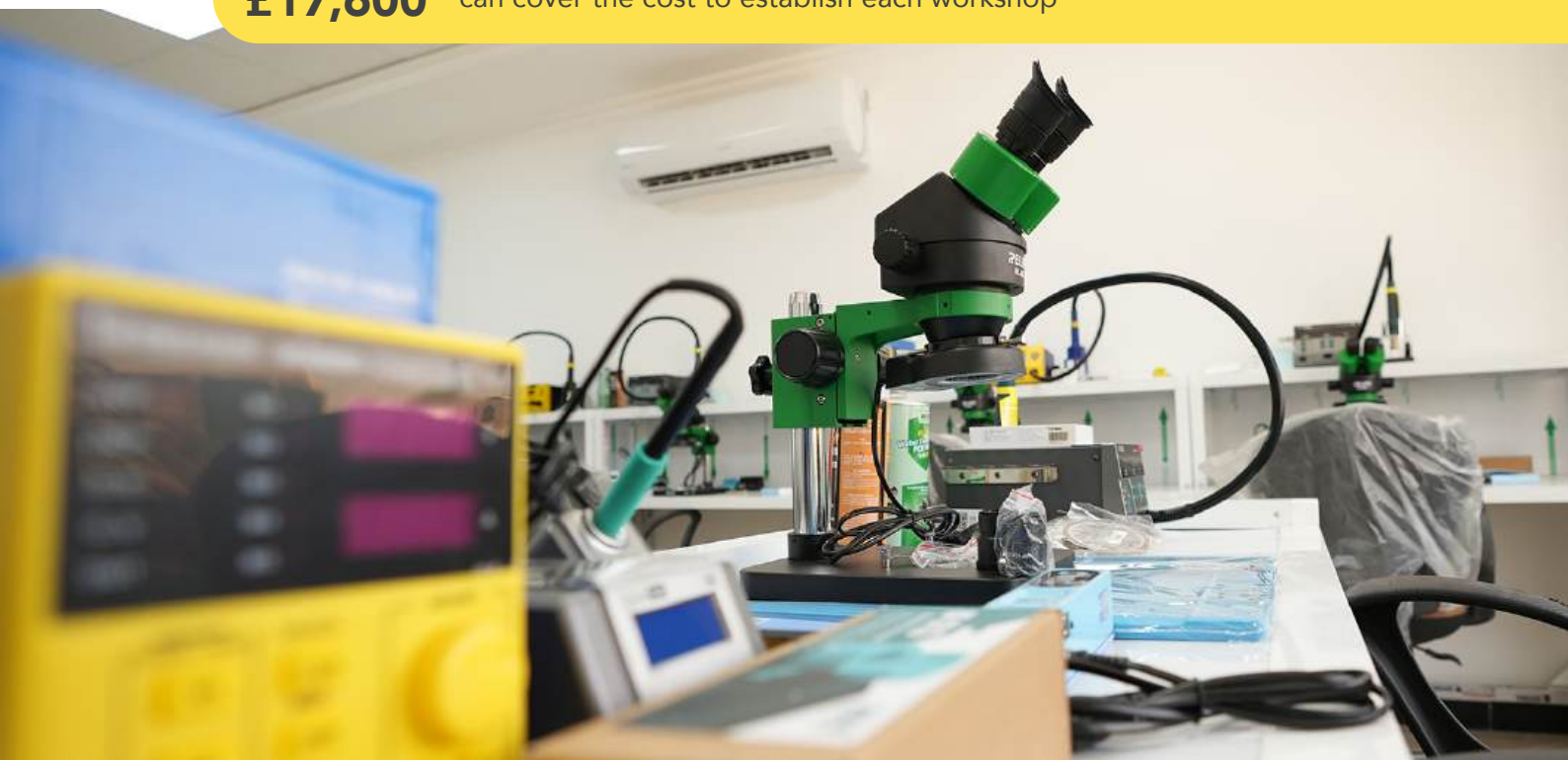
Workshops That Transform Futures

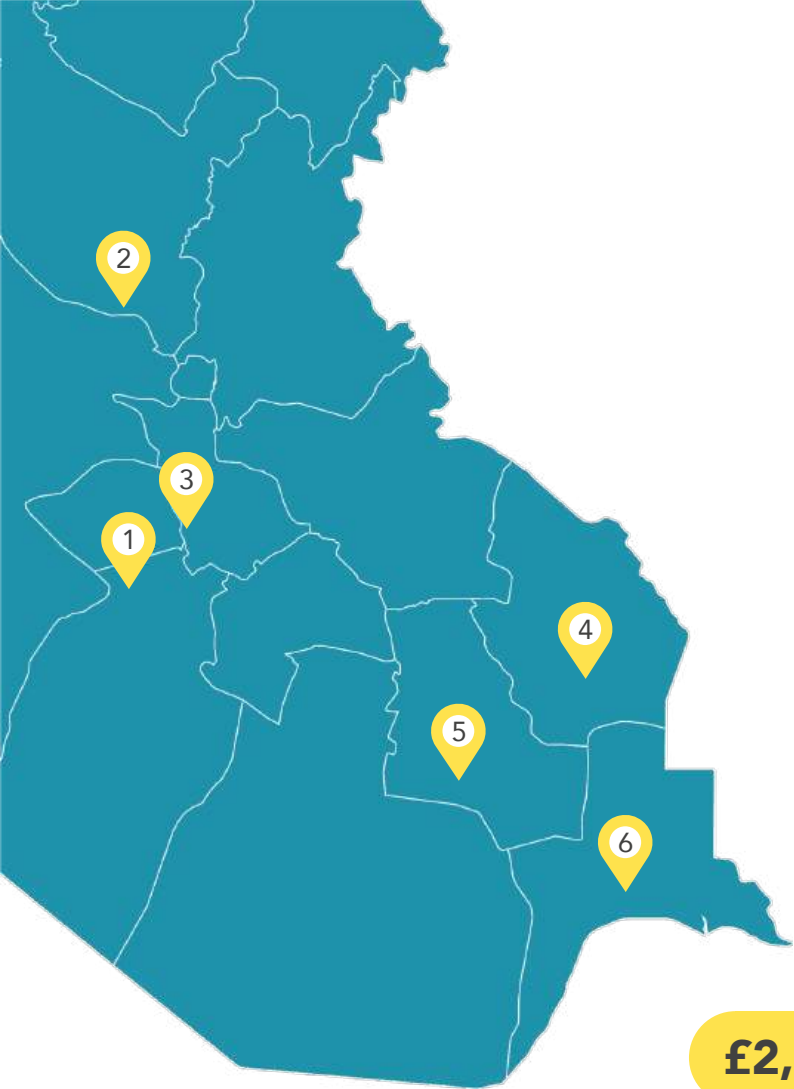
Among our services, vocational training plays a pivotal role in empowering youth and widowed mothers to achieve financial independence.

Our vocational training workshops provide participants with intensive, hands-on training in fields such as Hairdressing, IT/Phone Repairs, Catering, and Sewing. Following the training, participants gain practical experience through placements in local businesses. Many graduates go on to request microfinance loans from Al-Ayn to establish their own shops, creating sustainable livelihoods.

We are working to establish 49 vocational training workshops across our Luminous Stars Centres in Iraq.

Housing Projects: Building Complexes, Restoring Dignity

Across Iraq, our expert teams are transforming lives by creating safe and dignified living spaces for orphaned children and their families. Our housing projects create nurturing spaces where children can thrive emotionally, socially, and academically.

To address the broader housing crisis, marked by inadequate housing conditions, we construct purpose-built residential complexes designed to accommodate multiple families in need. These projects specifically aim to support orphaned children living below the poverty line, providing them with a safe, stable environment.

Help us provide security and stability to orphaned children and their families.

Support the construction of our Imam Baqir (AS) complex in Najaf

Located in the holy city of Najaf, this residential complex will consist of 66 housing units, each covering 100 square metres, providing a sanctuary for families who have endured severe hardships. It will offer a stable and nurturing environment where they can rebuild their lives with dignity.

The residential complex is partially built, and significant progress has been made in laying the groundwork for this initiative. Each unit within the complex is carefully designed to meet the basic needs of a family, ensuring privacy, comfort, and functionality. These homes include essential living spaces such as bedrooms, a kitchen, a bathroom, and a living area, all built to provide a sense of security and normalcy.

£12,350 can cover the cost to complete each remaining housing unit

This thoughtfully designed complex will feature 20 housing units, each spanning approximately 130 square metres. These homes will be built with families in mind, offering well-planned layouts that include essential living spaces such as bedrooms, a kitchen, a bathroom, and a living area. The units will also include modern fixtures and fittings, ensuring comfort and functionality.

£45,700
